Information For Fencers & Parents

Classes start at the advertised time, please arrive on time for your class.

Fencers should bring a bottle of drinking water with their name or other identifying mark on it. They should dress for sport – sneakers, track-pants and t-shirt. Please do not bring sugary drinks, and be aware that food cannot be taken into the hall at Mitcham.

Please note that legs must be covered, **shorts are not permitted** for safety reasons.

Saturday classes are held in the Stadium of the Nunawading Community Centre.

Weekday classes are held in the hall at Sportlink, Vermont South.

Please note that Nunawading front doors are kept locked on weekends. Rear doors to the stadium are usually kept open but it depends on the weather.

Family members are welcome to watch the class. If you are interested in volunteering to help with the classes, please discuss this with the coach.

If you will not be attending a class, please let us know not to expect you. A short e-mail or SMS is fine, even at the last minute.

The class cost must be paid by the start of the first session. All students (except Beginners) must also have Fencing Victoria affiliation and a club membership.

Your FV affiliation can be paid to Fencing Victoria directly, or through the club. We recommend direct payment for fencers intending to compete to ensure your competition entry is not impacted by any manual process delays.

We can provide advice should you wish to buy your own equipment, and some items can be purchased through the club. Package deals are available.

Club notices and announcements are sent out regularly by e-mail. While most information is also published on the website and facebook pages, if you don't receive the monthly updates then you should check spam and confirm we have your correct e-mail address.

Renewal payments can be made at the first session but **please ensure you register your intention to attend with the club beforehand**. Places in the classes are limited.

Age ranges for classes are provided as a guide, but generally the maturity and experience of the individual is a more important factor. We recommend individual lessons be taken in addition to classes. Please feel free to discuss your options with a coach at any time.
